

Distinguished Theologian to Speak in Weston

In keeping with its year-long program of special events, Weston's Church on the Hill is pleased to announce a visit to the church by distinguished Theologian, Author, and Lecturer Dr. Dermot A. Lane from Dublin, Ireland.

On Monday, July 15, Dr. Lane will make two presentations at the Church on the Hill for their series entitled "Perspectives on Spirituality." At 10:15 am, he will lecture on the topic "Interreligious Dialogue: A New Challenge for Christian Faith in the 21st Century". Again at 2:15 PM, he will present a follow-up talk entitled "Pneumatology: A Way Forward for Dialogue with Other Religions."

Dr. Lane is recently retired President of Mater Dei Institute of Education in Dublin, Ireland. He is widely known as a lecturer throughout Ireland, the UK and Canada. In alternate summers, he teaches Theology at the University of Dayton, Ohio, and St. Michaels College in Colchester, VT. He has published many articles. His books include *The Reality of Jesus* (translated into Chinese last year); *Process, Praxis and Salvation* (translated into Spanish in 1991), *The Experience of God: An Invitation to do Theology*, and *Keeping Hope Alive: Stirrings in Christian Theology*. His most recent book is *Stepping Stones to Other Religions: A Christian Theology of Interreligious Dialogue*. Forthcoming in 2013 is *Religion and Education: Reimagining the Relationship*.

In addition to teaching and writing, Rev. Lane serves as Pastor at the Church of the Ascension, Balally Parish, in south Dublin. His bright, warm and compassionate personality makes his words memorable.
